The Project:



The project aims for the Upskilling and inclusion of immigrant women in society as useful and productive members. For the achievement of the above aims, we intend to properly train Migrant Women, in ICT technologies and applications, in the hopes that the women who have an affinity for ICT will be able to start a career in the field, thus making them more attractive to the labour market and improving their confidence and self-worth. This will have as an additional result to help the Migrant Women become part of a growing market, since the need for ICT skills is ever growing, and give them the means to provide for themselves. We will also coach Migrant Women in job seeking and job interviews in order to increase their employability and better their chances at finding a job in the field they enjoy. The members of the Migrant Women will be properly trained:

- On Information and Communication Technologies
- On Job Seeking

Target Group of the Project:

The **target group** of the project is “**Migrant Women**”, who will have access to professional training. They are a group of people who have no access to training and education systems and are very unlikely to become valuable and productive members of society, thus increasing the chances that they will be mistreated and marginalised. They will be trained properly on ICT technologies and applications in order to increase their employability and self-initiative.
